

The Dog Family

The dog family is one of the 11 families that make up the Carnivores, a large group of intelligent, flesh-eating, backboned animals. In this group are such varied animals as bears, pandas, raccoons, cats, hyenas and even seal. The dog on canine family has many wild spices like wolves, foxes, coyotes, jackals and wild dogs.

The dog is the only domesticated member of the canine family through now and then someone tames a wolf, fox or coyote as a pet. All members of the dog family are descendant of a wolf-like animal which lived about 15 million years ago. From this distant ancestor, the true dogs gradually developed. But nobody knows the exact ancestor of the modern domestic dog.




