The place, people, thing and nature that surround any living organism is called environment.

2. What is lithosphere?

It is the solid crust or the hard top layer of the earth. It is made or rocks and minerals and covered by a thin layer of soil.

3. What are the components of lithosphere?

Lithosphere is the domain that provides us for ests, grasslands for grazing, and land for agriculture and human settlements. It is a source of rich mineral wealth.

4. What is hydrosphere? What does it contain?

The domain of water is called hydrosphere. It consists of various sources of water and different types of water bodies like rivers, lakes, seas, oceans etc.,

5. What is atmosphere?
